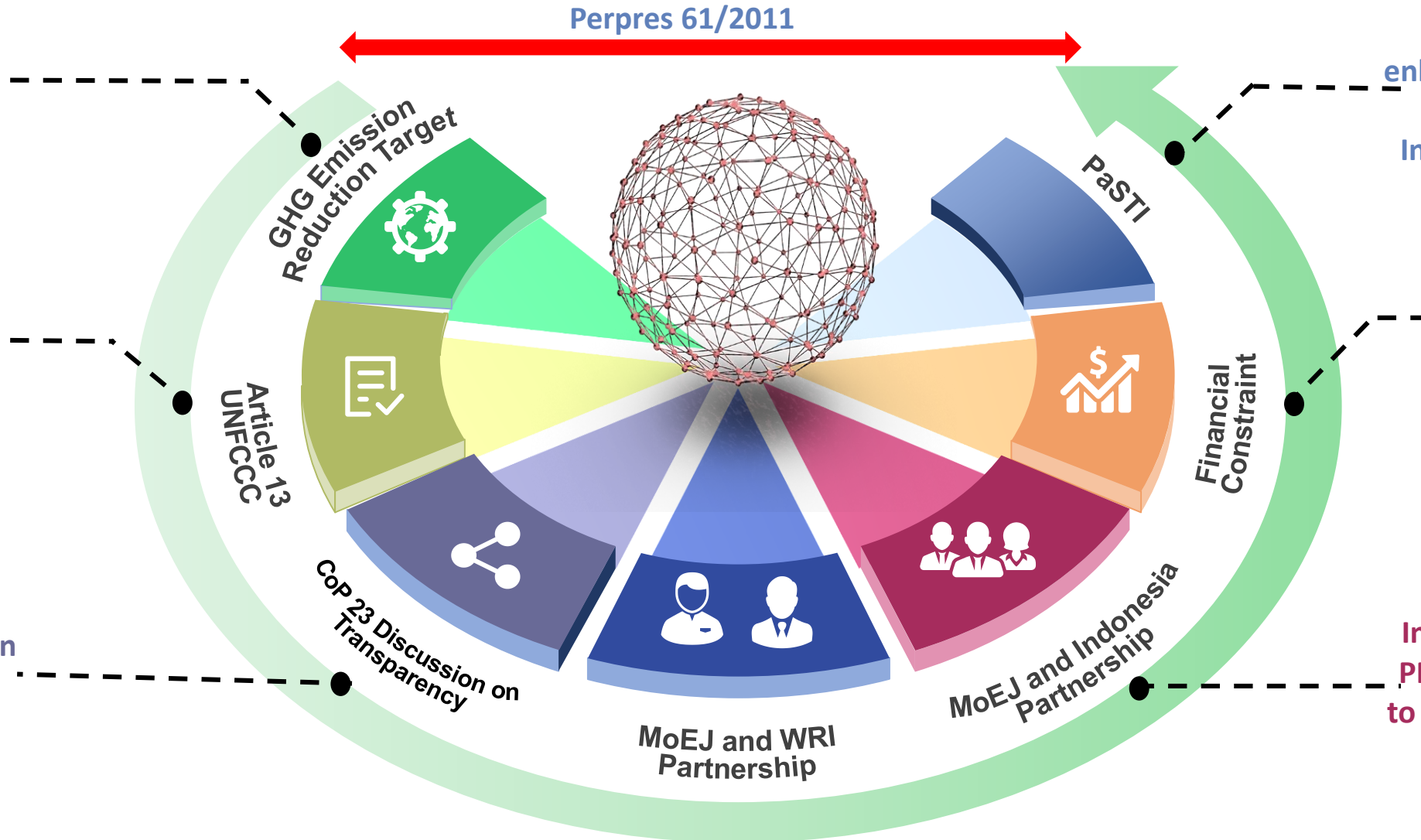
# PaSTI's Key Background

A new financial mechanism for Indonesia government reaching Indonesia NDC/INDC target

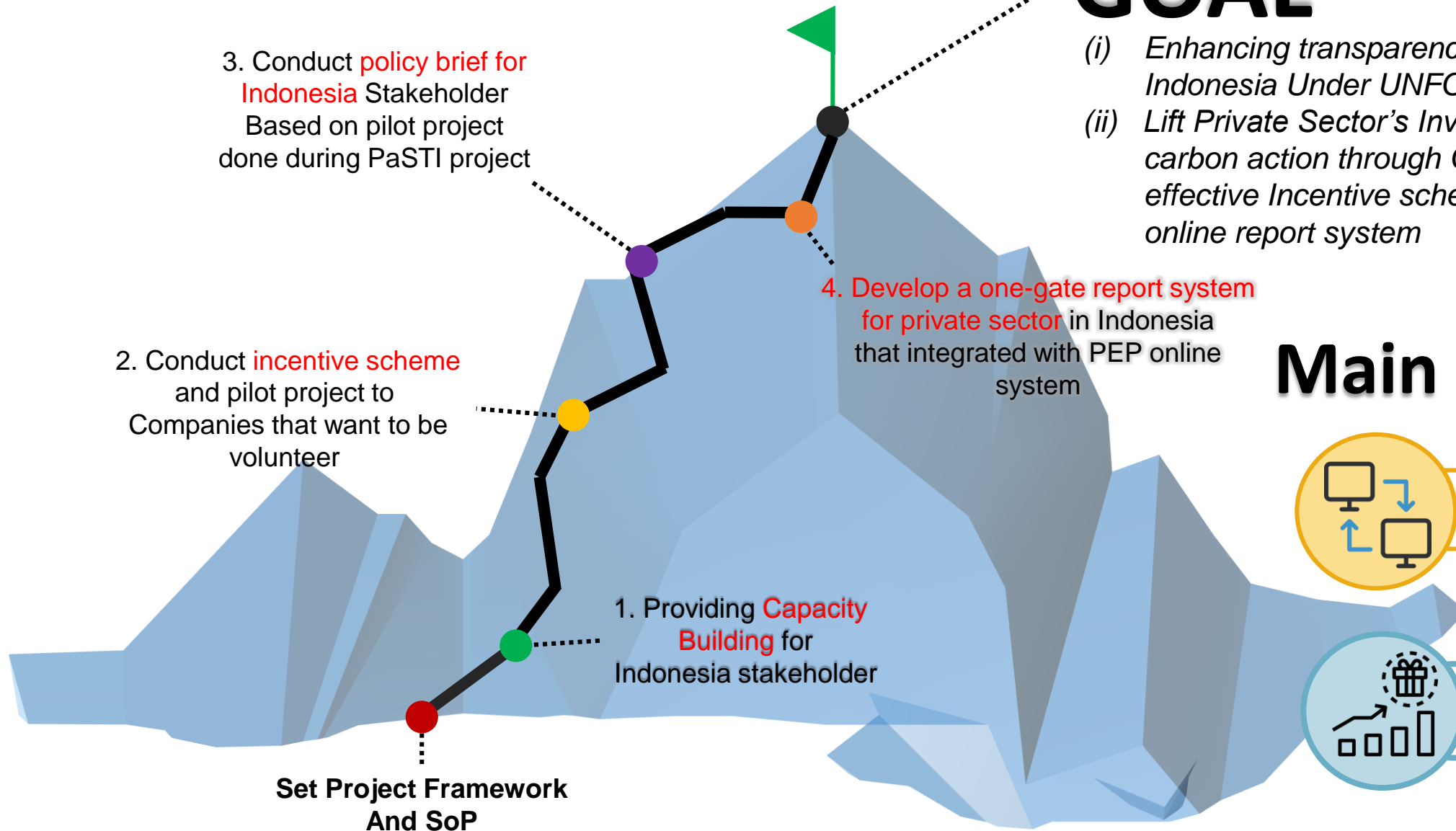
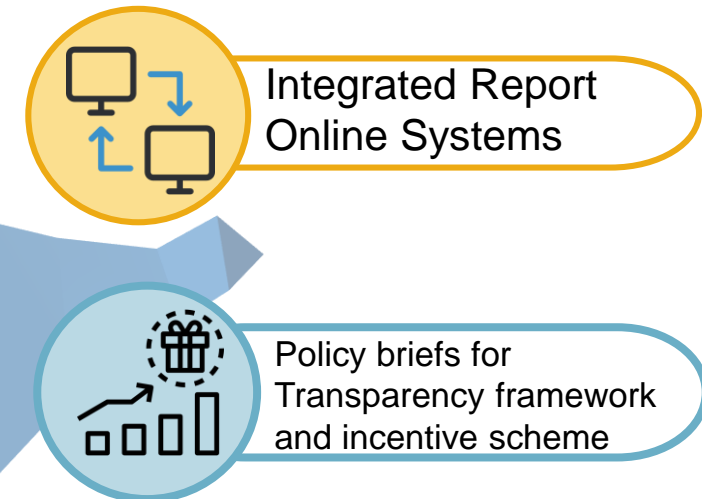
In CoP 23, Ministry of PPN/Bappenas agree to work together with MoEJ in regards to enhancing transparency framework in Indonesia

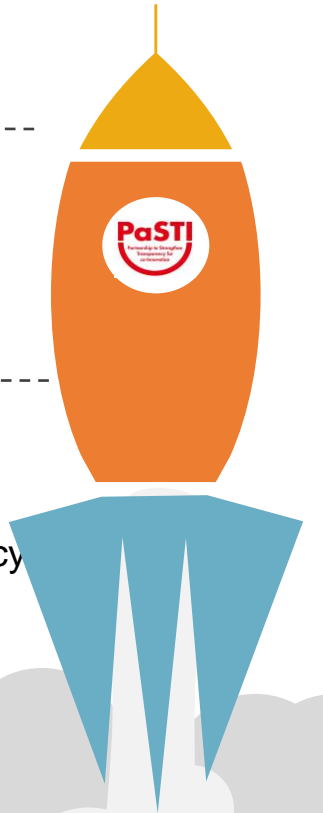

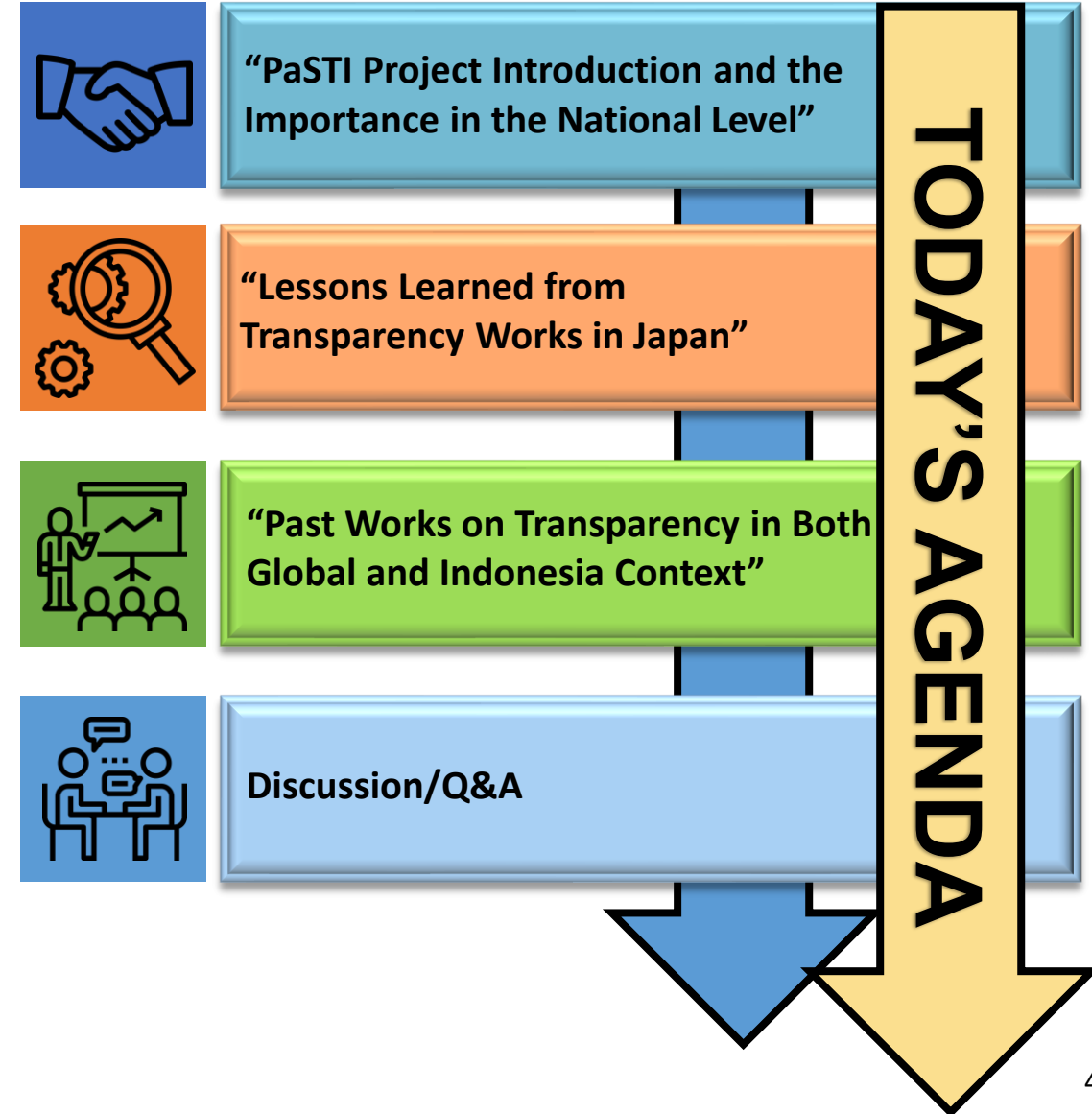
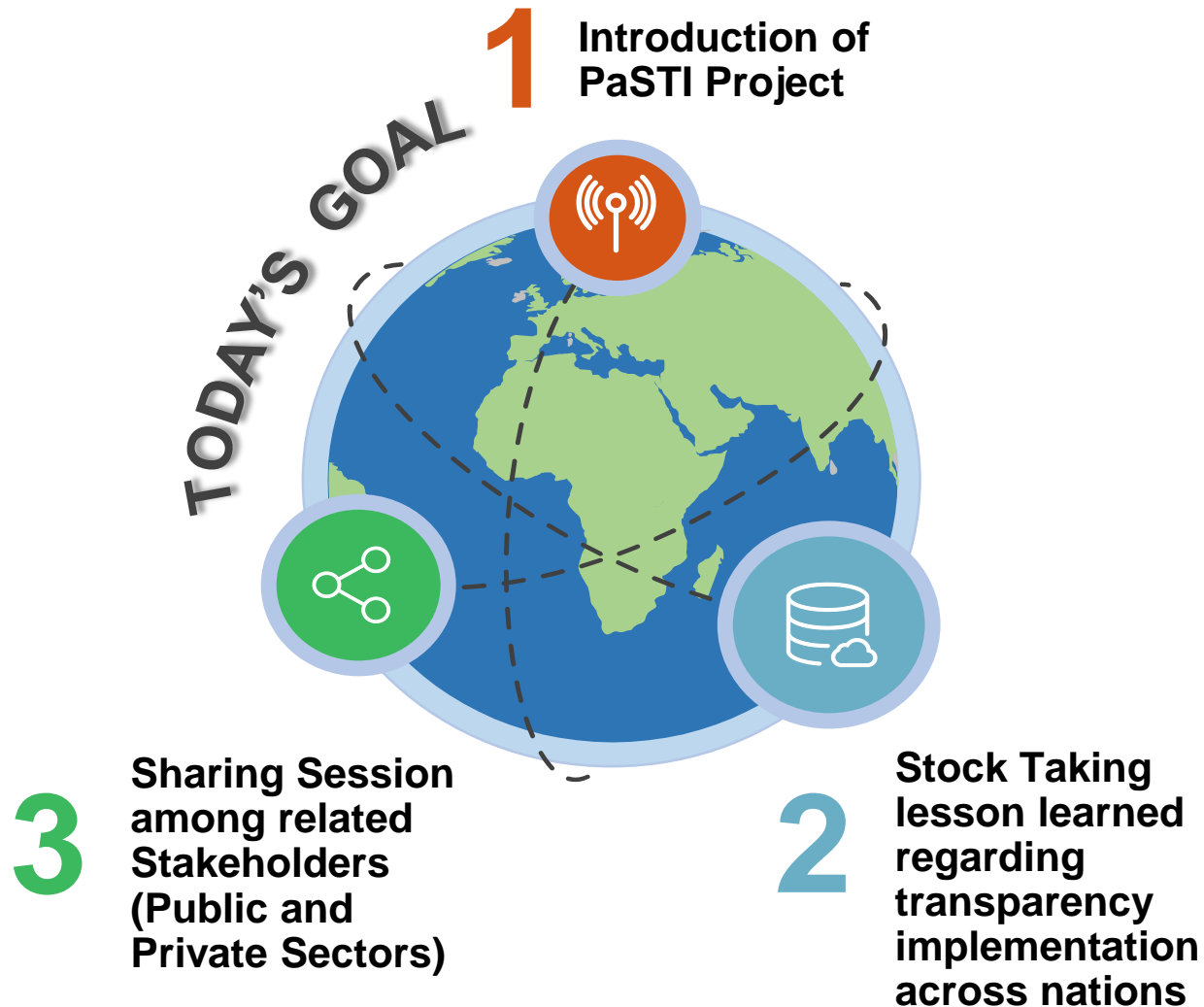
